**NOTE**

**1. FOR CASES OF MERGED TRIBAL DISTRICTS**


The grant of PL/ML shall be subject to the conditions that:

- i. If the granted area falls in the designated forest land subsequent to the approval by the Provincial cabinet and declaration of designated forest land in Merged Tribal Districts, the forest land will be declined from the granted area and the leasee will not undertake any mining operations in the forest land.
- ii. The leasee will not carry out mining operations in plantation areas under BTAP or any other scheme till the expiry of the agreement signed between Forest Department and Owners.
- iii. That Granted lease area in all cases is demarcated on ground in consonance with Section 33 of the Mineral Governance Act, 2017 in the presence of DFO or his authorized representative.
- iv. EIA/IEE shall be mandatory as per Section 13 of the EPA Act, 2014.

**2. FOR CASES FALLING IN DISTRICTS OTHER THAN MERGED AREA**

The grant of PL/ML shall be subject to the conditions that:

- i. The revised sketch after declining the forest land is submitted by the applicant before awarding allotment letter.
- ii. The leasee will not carry out mining operations in plantation areas under BTAP or any other scheme till the expiry of agreement deed executed between Forest Department and land owners.
- iii. That Granted lease area in all cases is demarcated on ground in consonance with Section 33 of the Mineral Governance Act, 2017 in the presence of DFO or his authorized representative to exclude forest land including resume land/waste land (as the GIS data of resume/waste land is not yet available).
- iv. EIA/IEE shall be mandatory as per Section 13 of the EPA Act, 2014.
