Reference your office letter No. SO(Tech)/FE&WD/N-210/2021/KC/1809-12 dated 06.12.2021.

Please refer to the above cited letter and it is submitted that the undersigned attended Mineral Titles Committee meeting scheduled on 23.12.2021 regarding Minerals grants in Merged Areas. At the start of the meeting the undersigned conveyed the concerns on behalf of the department regarding grant of Mineral Titles in Merged Areas Forest, which are duly recorded on the agenda items list enclosed for favor of information and ready reference, also reproduced below; - Attached

"The undersigned put forth the views on behalf of the Forest Department that all the Mineral Titles to be granted in Merged Areas may be kept pending for the time being, as there is required legal opinion after cabinet Approval with reference to status of Merged Areas Forests as Guzara Forests, although no Notification is issued/finalized. The representative of Mineral title argued that if granted at this stage the same will later on be declined, if that Forest Area is declared as Guzara forest, later on. And on the other side, under Section-35 of Minerals Act 2017, the Government will also be bound to give a Compensation to the ML/PL Lease Holder, after cancellation of Lease. Hence the opinion be solicited from Law Department in the current situation for granting of Leases after approval/decision of Cabinet of declaration Merged Areas forests as Guzara forests, as later on cancellation will also lead to payment of compensation by the Government at a later stage".

The above may also be considered as dissenting note and may be communicated to quarter concerned for further necessary action, please.

Moreover, Advocate General Office be also approached for a legal opinion in the instant matter please.
